POSITION SUMMARY:

This position is to assist with the grain harvest season and is based out of our Yantzi's Feed & Seed location in Tavistock, ON. The Grain Elevator Assistant supports the operations and executes activities, in accordance with established guidelines, to achieve the production targets for the assigned area. This position is a seasonal (part-time) position and a flexible working schedule is needed for the months of October and November. After fulfillment of this term there could be a possibility for Full-Time employment or Annual Recurring Seasonal work (July, August, September, October and November). During peak hours during harvest, the employee will be expected to work a minimum of 40 hours per week, including weekends.

The Skilled Operator is the "basic" level of operator role, performing basic operational processes in the receiving, shipping and drying of grain. An understanding of agriculture and/or prior experience in a grain elevator setting would be an asset.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Executes operational activities such as discharge, load, transport, label and operate equipment;
- Periodically inspects and executes small maintenance tasks on the production equipment;
- Logs data on production activities in order to have achieve accuracy;
- Identifies opportunities for improvement in order to continuously optimize and improve operational processes;
- Works in compliance and promotes awareness with all relevant safety, environmental and quality standards;
- Ensures the work area is left clean and in a safe working condition and that there are no hazardous situations.

PREFERRED HIRING CRITERIA:

- Grade 12 or equivalent;
- Transportation to and from work site;
- Heavy physical effort is required and ability to climb ladders;
- Positive work ethic and attitude; willingness and ability to learn; strong team and interpersonal skills;
